# THE GHANAIAN DREAM PROJECT

THE GHANAIAN DREAM PROJECT (GDP) is an innovative, educative and motivational programme which provide interactive platforms to educate, orient, and motivate the youth and students to develop a positive mental attitude, a sense of purpose, responsibility and to cherish the values of patriotism.

The target group for the programme includes students in junior, senior and tertiary institutions, as well as youth organizations.

In February 2015, the motivational 'train' made a stop at twenty one (21) Senior High schools and one tertiary Institution in the Northern Region of Ghana, which was a great success, considering the feedback. The responses from these higher institutions were so touching, considering the testimonies from some of the students. It really marked a watershed for some of them.

The team had the opportunity to visit 17 Senior High schools in Tamale the capital town of Northern Region and 4 schools in Yendi municipality; in total we visited 21 high schools. Over 25,000,00 students participated in the programme.

A total number of 441 post evaluation questionnaires were administered throughout the participatory schools, which included both the teachers and students, aimed at finding out how the GDP is impacting the participants and how they are buying into the concept of the project.

The students' forms provided were about 420 and the teachers' forms 21. However, out of these 441 survey forms provided, a total of 354 questionnaires with responses were submitted to the GDP team. Hence, 87 questionnaires were not accounted for. It is assumed that these 87 participants' forms were never completed;



participants failed to submit them after the programme or the questionnaires were misplaced.

The questionnaire looked at rating of the programme, what they leant from the programme and its future prospects, asking students if they would like to be part of the project again.

All the 337 students who participated in the evaluation process, answered in the affirmative; they would be glad to be part of the programme in their school again. And 295 out of 337 rated the programme: excellent. 31 rated it good, 2 rated fair and 10 didn't rate it or give any response.

A total of 17 out of 21 forms were submitted back to the GDP team by teachers. The teachers questionnaire was intended to have a reasonably open approach, thus giving respondents the opportunity to express in a narrative form, their personal reflections. Some brief background information was also asked for. Generally, the responses were very informative.
